Father's Ramblings



The link between the First Reading and Gospel is not immediately apparent today, until you look at the "headings" which are always chosen "to make the connection between readings of the same Mass clear." (Introduction to the Lectionary n.123.) The "headings" present us with a simple picture today: a river of peace flowing out from the Lord, which we see

in the Gospel as the flowing of the disciples as they are sent out on their first mission. From the Lord of Peace, others, like ripples in a pool, flow out carrying his simple message: "Peace to this house!"

On Tuesday of this week I spent time with the staff of our primary school as they, together with the Governors, explored the ongoing vision for our school. The session was very informative and a good number of ideas emerged for how we can take the school forward in the future.

Wednesday saw the Solemnity of St Peter and Paul. This is the first holy day of obligation that we have celebrated since the return of obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days, after the Pandemic. A gentle reminder that watching Mass at home via the internet NO LONGER FULFILS the obligation unless prevented by illness or some other serious reason. It's always much better to be together in community for the celebration of Mass rather than in isolation from each other in our own homes.



After Masses on Wednesday I hotfooted it up to the Highlands of Motherwell to be present at the ordination of Christopher Morris to the priesthood. An ordination is always a time of great joy in the life of the Church and particularly for priests as they are reminded of the joy of their own ordination. Bishop Toal spoke warmly and reminisced about his own time as a newly ordained priest. Please keep Fr. Christopher in your prayers as he begins his priestly ministry. He has been appointed to the parish and shrine in Carfin. The picture shows Chris after his ordination to the Diaconate - one of the steps on the way to the priesthood.

Friday morning will see the installation of our new digital bell system to replace the old one that had unfortunately seen better days. The bells will ring out on the hour (but not through the night!) and play the 'Lourdes Hymn' at 12:00noon and 6:00pm each day. They will also toll for funerals and peal joyously for weddings and other events in the life of our parish.
