# Father's Ramblings



The week gone by has been one of meetings and priestly fraternity. On Tuesday I gathered with my confreres of The Institute of Christ Sovereign Priest (ICKSP), of whom I am an affiliate member, to celebrate with Canon Amaury Montjean his twentieth anniversary of ordination with Solemn Te Deum and Benediction.

This was followed by a reception in the parish hall.

On Wednesday our gathering was more solemn as priests from the Diocese and beyond gathered with Bishop John and Bishop Terence for the Requiem Mass for Canon Moss O'Connell PP St Joseph's, Reddish. Do please keep Canon Moss and his family in your prayers at this time.





After the Mass I gathered with a few friends to plan our road trip to Lourdes for the Diocesan Pilgrimage. We are heading out on the Monday before and driving to Lourdes stopping off at Caen, Alençon, Saumur and Rocamadour before arriving in Lourdes on the Friday afternoon for the pilgrimage.

On Thursday I gathered with a few priests and architects to hear more of the reordering project being undertaken at the Cathedral. Lots of much needed
